The increased calories enhanced calf development and the scale weights were 8 to 20 pounds heavier compared to 2013. Don't let that scare you: these are the same great genetics that we've always offered to our customers. When visiting with our local neighbors and even producers from other states such as Montana, Kansas and Colorado, it seemed that they were all experiencing heavier birth weights as well. It seems that the ice kept the good old girls from getting their exercise.

Every calf in this offering was born unassisted, and when they hit the ground they were very aggressive and up sucking. We did have some heavier calves; those were cut and sold as steers. We did not want to offer any that would give you calving problems.

We have a great selection of percentage bulls along with several 7/8 Simmental bulls. We have some customers wanting high percentage Simmental, so we made some. A twist to the heifer bull division – the MX01 sons are big time carcass bulls, with "maternal" stamped all over them. The Angus bulls are long-aged or 18-month-old-bulls. Ten out of the 12 are heifer bulls with five of them sired by one of today's hottest Angus bulls: PA Power Tool.

Feel free to stop in for a cup of coffee prior to the sale and take a look at this enticing set of bulls. There is truly something here for everyone.

If a problem occurs contact Wicks Cattle immediately and a suitable replacement will be furnished or credit minus any salvage will be given towards next year's sale. The buyer may choose the options. This guarantee does not cover death of the animal. All claims must be submitted by September 1, 2015. Bulls will be semen checked prior to delivery, which is April 15, 2015. Guarantee is null and void if injury/death is sustained due to negligence under the care of new owner.

BRAND INSPECTION: A brand inspector will be available Sale Day.

RETAINED SEMEN INTEREST: Wicks Cattle is retaining 1/3 interest share in every bull selling in this sale. Full possession and full salvage value sell with the bull.

ANNOUNCEMENTS: Announcements made sale day take precedence over any printed material.

ANY PERSON ATTENDING THE SALE DOES SO AT HIS OWN RISK. Neither the owners, nor any person connected with this sale assumes any liability, legal or otherwise.

DELIVERY: Wicks Cattle will keep and feed your yearling bulls after the sale until April 15, 2015. We will tend to your purchases like they are our own. The bulls will be semen tested, poured and two rounds of the foot rot shot will be given. If you choose to do this there will be \$150 per bull collected on sale day. Wicks Cattle has done this program in prior years, the results have been great and the new owners are pleased with their new herd bull purchases. Free delivery is provided by us or you are welcome to take your bulls home the day of the sale and bring them back for the semen test, April 15, 2015.

The long-age bulls will be delivered starting after the sale. The long-age bulls have been semen tested and trich-tested and are ready-to-go.

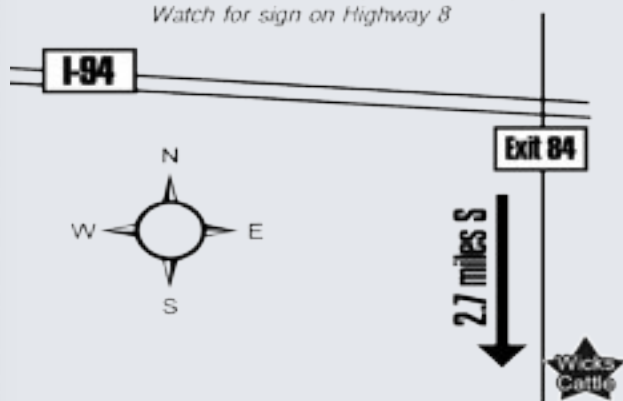

Quick Guide to ASA EPDs and Indexes

Expected Progeny Differences (EPDs): EPDs are the most accurate and effective tool available for comparing genetic levels. In using EPDs, the difference between two sires' EPDs represents the unit difference expected in the performance of their progeny. For example, if sires A and B have EPDs of +10 and - 5, a 15-unit difference would be expected in their progeny (moving from -5 to +10 yields 15 units). Key to using EPDs is knowing in what units they are expressed. For example, if the above case referred to weaning weight EPDs, sire A would be expected to sire 15 pounds more weaning weight than sire B. If calving ease was the trait, sire A would be expected to sire 15 percent more unassisted births in first-calf heifers; in other words, if sire B sired 30 assists in a group of 100 heifers, we would expect sire A to require 15 assists. A percentile-ranking chart is required to determine where a bull's EPDs rank him relative to other bulls in the breed. For more detailed information about EPDs and \$ indexes, visit www.simmental.org. Listed below are the units in which ASA EPDs are expressed:

- **All-Purpose Index (API):** Dollars per cow exposed under an all-purpose-sire scenario. (See \$ Indexes for more details.)
- **Back Fat (BF):** Inches of carcass backfat at 475 days.
- **Birth Weight (BW):** Pounds of birth weight.
- **Calving Ease (CE):** Percentage of unassisted births when used on heifers.
- **Carcass Weight (CW):** Pounds of carcass weight at 475 days.
- **Docility (DOC):** Percentage of offspring receiving a disposition score of 1 (docile).
- **Maternal Calving Ease (MCE):** Percentage of unassisted births in first-calving daughters.
- **Milk (MLK):** Pounds of weaning weight due to milk.
- **Marbling (MRB):** Carcass marbling score at 475 days.
- **Maternal Weaning Weight (MWW):** Pounds of weaning weight due to milk and growth.
- **Ribeye Area (REA):** Square inches of carcass ribeye at 475 days. Stayability (STAY): Percentage of daughters remaining in the cowherd at six years of age.
- **Terminal Index (TI):** Dollars per cow exposed under a terminal-sire scenario. (See TI for more details.)
- **Warner-Bratzler Shear Force (WBSF):** Pounds of force required to shear a rib-eye steak.
- **Weaning Weight (WW):** Pounds of weaning weight.
- **Yearling Weight (YW):** Pounds of yearling weight.
- **Yield Grade (YG):** Carcass yield grade score at 475 days.

\$ Indexes: Though EPDs allow for the comparison of genetic levels for many economically important traits, they only provide pieces of the economic puzzle. This is where \$ indexes come in.

Through well-conceived, rigorous mathematical computation, \$ indexes blend EPDs and economics to estimate an animal's overall impact on integrated commercial production. The same technology that led to the dramatic progress in swine, poultry and dairy genetics over the last several decades was used to develop the following \$ indexes:

- **All-Purpose Index (API):** Evaluates sires for use on the entire cow herd (bred to both Angus first-calf heifers and mature cows) with the portion of their daughters required to maintain herd size retained and the remaining heifers and steers put on feed and sold grade and yield.
- **Terminal Index (TI):** Evaluates sires for use on mature Angus cows with all offspring put on feed and sold grade and yield.
- **Using API and TI:** First, determine which index to use; if you are keeping replacements use API, if not, use TI. Then, just as with EPDs, zero in on the unit difference between bulls. (As described above, index units are in dollars per cow exposed.) The difference can be used to determine how much a bull is worth compared to another. Put another way, how much you can pay for one bull compared to another. For example, when buying an all-purpose-type sire, you can quickly figure a bull scoring +100 for API is worth an extra \$6,000 over a +50 bull if both are exposed to 30 cows over 4 years (\$50 diff. x 30 hd. x 4 yr. = \$6,000). A percentileranking chart is required to determine where a bull's index value ranks him relative to other bulls in the breed. For more detailed information about EPDs and \$ indexes, visit www.simmental.org.
- **Important disclaimer:** DO NOT compare index values of purebreds of different breeds, hybrids of different breed composition or purebreds with hybrids — our system was not developed to make valid comparison among these groups. Therefore, you must first determine the breed and breed composition appropriate for your herd and use index values to compare animals within that population.
